- CAPEX MD Point of Need Loans possible microloans up to \$10,000 for individuals with lower credit scores
 - Cade would be the "middle man" only grant applicants would be eligible to apply and funds would be distributed to CADE and CADE would distribute the money to the recipient
 - o Only can get the loan for the request made, not the amount that they would qualify for
 - o CADE would not be involved in any repayment issues
