Programs and Initiatives

Family-Building Grants:

In 2023, we awarded 10 grants totaling \$150,000 to help families cover the costs of infertility treatments and adoption.

Educational Workshops:

We hosted 15 workshops nationwide, educating over 5,000 attendees (in person + online combined) about infertility options and resources.

Advocacy and Awareness Campaigns:

Our #FamiliesAreBuilt campaign reached over 1 million people, raising awareness about infertility and reducing stigma.


